

## SEBEKA SCHOOL SUPPLY LIST

### GRADES K-6

2014-2015

Elementary Classroom supply lists will be available at local merchants in Sebeka, Menahga, Wadena and Park Rapids. They will also be submitted to Target's electronic listing. We encourage you to shop locally, remembering all the community support the school receives. But, should you buy at Target with a Target charge card, please designate that their contribution should go to the Sebeka Elementary School for supplies.

#### **PRESCHOOL**

1. One box of tissues
2. One backpack large enough to fit papers, snow pants, etc.
3. A change of clothes to be left at school

#### **KINDERGARTEN:**

The following supplies are needed at the beginning of the school year. Your child may bring them to the kindergarten Orientation/Open House in August if they don't want to carry them on the first day of kindergarten. Please label the inside of your child's backpack, gym shoes, and warm outdoor clothing (boots and snow pants) with your child's name or initials.

1. Large Backpack or school bag that closes – to carry things back and forth to school every day.
2. Gym shoes with laces that tie – These are to be left at school to be used in Phy Ed class. It is not necessary that they be new – just clean. (non-marking with no felt on the bottom)
3. Box of Kleenex – regular size (144 ct. or 250 ct.) – to be shared with the class.
4. Crackers for milk break – These will be shared with the class.
5. Zip lock bags – We use a variety of zipper bags throughout the year. Please consider donating snack size **or** sandwich size.
6. Cheap paper plates – we prefer the thin white plates. Please consider donating small desert size **or** regular lunch size.

The following supplies will be mixed and shared in the classroom throughout the school year:

7. Glue sticks – 2 glue sticks
8. Crayons – 1 box of large size crayons – 8 count basic colors AND 1 box of regular size crayons – 16 count.
9. Markers – 1 box of large size washable Classic Colors – 8 count

4. (1) plastic pencil box (maximum of 6” wide; regular rectangular ones are fine just not large ones)
5. (1) bottle of glue
6. (5) glue sticks
7. (1) box of crayons
8. (1) package of colored pencils
9. (1) package of unscented, washable markers
10. (1) wide-ruled spiral notebook

The following items will be kept together and shared with the whole class:

11. (24) #2 pencils plain, not decorated (made of real wood; the other ones just won't sharpen well!)
12. (3) large pink erasers
13. (1) large box of tissues
