We will work on some sort of food service program to assist families in need. We are also waiting for guidance regarding child care concerns.

Some schools in our area plan to shutdown early this week although Sebeka School will be open March 16th and 17th to give families time to prepare as well as students the opportunity to receive valuable information for their educational needs during the shutdown. If you chose to keep your kids home the next two days, that will be your choice and we understand.

After meeting with teachers we will develop an educational plan for delivery of instruction should the shutdown take place for an extended period of time. All after school activities are canceled effective immediately.
