

School Lunches to be delivered during the shutdown

We will start the delivery of meals on Thursday, March 19th.

Buses will leave the school at 9:00 a.m. Your household will receive a phone call relating the time when the bus or van will arrive.

Buses will stop at the pickup/drop off location where your children get on and off the bus. The same location will be the drop off area each day. We will not accommodate several locations.

Meals will be provided at the door of the bus or van. A family member is expected to pick up the meals from the bus or van.

A waiver form will be sent with the first meal that will need to be signed and returned to the school.

The schedule for meals will be this week Thursday and Friday mornings.

Next Monday, March 23rd is a scheduled in-service day. No child care or meals will be provided on this date.

Next week the meals will be delivered on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.

Wednesday's meal will include two breakfasts and two lunches one set for Wednesday and one set for Thursday.

The delivery will be the same each day. We expect families to arrive and pick up meals when the bus or van is there.

If someone is not at the drop off point, the meals will be brought back to the school and you can pick up your meals at the school.

Next week we will send out more information about the distance learning providing parents with the expectations of how this delivery system will look providing the shutdown continues.
